2012 NEA and WEA Delegate Ballot: **Electronic Voting**

February 3, 2012 (12:01 AM PST) – February 15, 2012 (11:59 PM PST)

The Seattle Education Association's NEA and WEA Delegate Election is conducted by electronic ballot. Members may use the Internet or the phone to vote. Seattle Education Association uses BallotPoint Election Services voting system. How to vote

Initial Login requires a member to enter their **SPS employee ID number**. DO NOT enter any leading zeros (0).

The initial PIN number is the member's **zip code** that is on file with SEA. (If your current zip code doesn't work, try the one you previously lived at.)

On the first successful login, you will be asked to create a PIN number that only you know.

Remember this number so you can login again if you need to. Your zip code will be over-ridden by your new PIN.

Follow the prompts to vote.

If you change your mind after voting, you can vote again. The system will count the last vote you submit prior to the end of the voting period – February 15, 2012, 11:59 PM.

WRITE-Ins:

If you want to be a write-in Candidate, declare by Monday, February 6 by doing the following:

You must obtain a new ID number on or before February 6. Members will have to vote for write-in candidates using your new ID number. The Elections Committee agreed to authorize write-in candidates to use their phone number on the SPS Directory as their ID number – making it easy for other members to look up the write-in candidate's number. But the Elections Committee has to know this number ahead of time and change your ID number in the voting system – So call us at (206) 283-8443 x 119.

To vote for write-in candidate(s): Find out the write-in candidate's ID number and enter that/those number(s) in the write-in slot(s).
