<u>Goals for the year</u>: Our main goals are outreach and organizing SPS substitutes, and preparing for bargaining a new contract. We will also focus on addressing Substitute concerns through labor/management meetings, representation, grievances, and planning PD.

Meetings and Events:

<u>WEA Rep. Assembly</u> (Apr. 19 - 21) - Several subs attended and were quite active proposing new items. Unfortunately Karin Engstrom's proposal to promote para sub professional development failed, but other subsponsored motions passed, such as supporting students who are suing to stop global warming.

<u>SSA General Meeting</u> (Apr. 26) - Kim VanAtta presented to the group on how to access the sub Schoology page. We elected Elisabeth Lavaris as Secretary/Treasurer and Justin Vinson as SSA At Large representative to SEA board, for 2 year terms (2018-19, 2019-20). We elected the following representatives for 2018-19: Joyce McDonald, Molly O'Neil, Edith Ruby, Darren Hoop, Whitney Parker/Kahn, Matthew Maley, and Francisca Zavala. Karin Engstrom proposed an amendment to the SSA bylaws to allow an expansion of our board from 8 members to 12. We will vote on this at our June meeting.

<u>Meeting with IT</u> (May 1) – Michael Melonson, John Donaghy and I met with John Krull, head of DoTS (Department of Tech. Services) to talk about the laptop rollout. Subs no longer have access to a teacher station, but it seems that subs are dealing with this by using the presentation station.

<u>Labor/Management Meeting</u> (May 10) - Very abbreviated. We are trying to start an "interest based" bargaining process to address how incident reports are written, and to give subs more of a chance to present their story. The next L/M meeting is on May 22.

Current grievances/actions:

- **Payroll issues**. There was a glitch in May but all accumulated sick time should be showing up on our pay stubs. The three different types are carried over year to year and may be used interchangeably. However there are no plans to make the rest of the pay warrant readable. - Did you know... If you are a cert in a 90+ day position (i.e. you are earning TRI) and you work through the end of the year, your district-paid insurance benefits are continued for an extra month (till the end of October).
- Sick leave for daily subs. We thought we agreed that subs don't need to sign up for a job in order to take a sick day. SPS is researching this. In the meantime, "Call Monica".
- Getting blocked for calling in sick. If you drop a job in AESOP within 12 hours, you must contact the sub office and school, else you might get a letter that blocks you from the school. Way to treat subs with respect!
- Early Release Wednesdays. These are not early release days for subs. We are expected to work the hours posted in AESOP which should reflect an entire day. Subs may participate in building PD if appropriate. If not we can work on the on-line "safe schools" trainings, required yearly, or ask the office how you can help.
