#### **Current events and reminders:**

- If you drop an assignment... Schools are not notified automatically when you cancel a job on AESOP. Please inform the school directly. This is especially true if you cancel a job within 12 hours of the start of the job.

- Wednesdays are full work days. We are expected to work the hours posted in AESOP which should reflect an
