What Happened at the table?

Today we re-examined the balance of flexible personal leave against substitute availability. We discussed how we fill positions when staff takes personal days. We also addressed the impact of not having all educator assignments in place when school starts and the impact on students when they don't start with that solid foundation.

We began addressing the fact that we have some high-needs schools with hard-to-fill positions.

Racial equity training continues to guide the whole team as we reflect on and utilize those learnings to find ways to better address issues and be more effective as staff.
