<u>Goals for the year</u>: Our main goals are still outreach and organizing SPS substitutes, and preparing for bargaining a new contract.

We will also focus on addressing Substitute concerns through labor/management meetings, representation, grievances, and planning PD.

Meetings and Events:

<u>SSA General Meeting</u> (Sept. 28). Because they were the only members nominated, we elected Stan Strasner as our new Vice President and Justin Vinson as our new "at large" board member. David Posner continues on the Sub Association board as District Liaison. These are interim positions, till regular elections are held next Spring for a 2 year term.

We also elected new Association Reps Dan Troccoli and Linda Zbigley.

A committee was formed to make recommendations re: a new "Sub Friendly" nomination/selection procedure, at our October meeting. If you have ideas please contact Peter Henry, Roberta Lindeman or Justin Vinson.

<u>Labor/Management Meeting</u> (Sept. 26). Check back in yet one more month about people to be paid for 1.1 FTE grievance. Several cert subs were paid at their contract rate from the start of their long-term positions, hooray Monical We pressed SPS to allow teachers the ability to select non-senior as well as senior subs. Currently they

need to get this done through the admin. secretary. We also reviewed problems with job posting times, for both cert and classified subs. There was agreement that it would be a good idea for classified subs to be able to attend selected PD on "early release" Wednesdays but no mechanism was proposed to make sure they are paid for a full day. We also determined that in theory all employees need to do "Safe Schools" online training yearly.

<u>Sub "Fail to Fill" Committee Meeting</u> (Oct. 5). The district has renamed the "sub shortage" committee because they realize there is no sub shortage, but there is still a problem for them of filling last-minute requests, often in south-end elementary schools. We will be polling membership to find out how much subs are working. There is a shortage of para subs. Part of this is due to inadequate training.

<u>PD for new subs and trainers (Oct. 13)</u>. This is a training being coordinated by WEA and SPS to assist new subs and to train experienced subs so we can do trainings. This is by invitation only.

Current grievances:

- 1.1 FTE payment issue at Rainier Beach HS. The proposed settlement is being reviewed by the district for the past few months.
- TRI The second sub list for 2013/14 has been reviewed. I submitted a revised list for 2012/13 and I still need to do this for 2014/15. I need to check up this and follow up.
- Contracts. The district is agreeable in theory to issuing contracts with flexible end dates (e.g. if teacher who is on leave comes back early). But no procedure is in place yet.

<u>Sub Directory</u>: I am developing a web application to help subs market themselves. Teachers and paras will be able to search for subs with specific skills, and then reach out to contact them. It is modeled on the "find a sub" page from the Edmonds Education Association: https://edmondsea.org/groups/esta/members/sub_catagories.php
